

Professor Hiroshi Ishida Office of University Professor, The University of Tokyo

Hiroshi Ishida is University Professor at the University of Tokyo and served as the Director of the Institute of Social Science and the Director of the Center of Social Research and Data Archives at the University of Tokyo. Ishida's research interests include comparative social mobility and social inequality over the life course. He is the author of *Social Mobility in Contemporary Japan* (Stanford University Press) and the co-editor with David Slater of *Social Class in Contemporary Japan* (Routledge). He received his Ph.D. in sociology from Harvard University and was a post-doctoral researcher at the University of Oxford and Associate Professor with tenure at Columbia University. He was a Visiting Professor of Sociology at the University of Michigan, a Visiting Fellow at Yale University, and a Fulbright Scholar at Harvard University. He was the editor-in-chief of *Social Science Japan Journal* published by Oxford University Press, and he currently directs the Japanese Life Course Panel Surveys.
