Bussarawan (Puk) Teerawichitchainan holds joint appointments as Associate Professor in the Department of Sociology and Co-Director of the Centre for Family and Population Research at the National University of Singapore. She received a Ph.D. from the University of Washington. Her research interests lie at the intersection of family demography, social gerontology, population health, and social stratification. Her current research examines the roles of family, policy, and social structure in explaining the life course and well-being of older adults in Southeast Asia. This includes an ongoing study on the long-term impacts of war and trauma exposure on the health and well-being of older Vietnamese war survivors and another study on childless aging in Singapore and Thailand. She is Deputy Editor of *Demography* and serves on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Gerontology: Social Sciences* and *Asian Population Studies*.
