Biography

Nobutada Yokouchi is a Project Associate Professor at the Centre for Social Research and Data Archives at the University of Tokyo. His research mainly focuses on how the psychosocial work environment impacts workers' psychological well-being over their careers or life course. He has experience in both qualitative and quantitative research methods. Besides his research, he works for the "Program for Strengthening Data Infrastructure for the Humanities and Social Science," funded by the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS). The program attempts to scale up the Japan Data Catalog for the Humanities and Social Sciences (JDCat), a data platform that promotes data sharing and utilization, where users can search metadata in Japanese and English across humanities and social sciences fields through a single point of entry.
