Biography

Wei Zhang is a Professor of Sociology at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. Her research interests include medical sociology and social gerontology, with a primary focus on health disparities affecting vulnerable populations, including racial and ethnic minorities as well as older adults. She investigates the interplay of various social factors — such as cultural traits, social support, socioeconomic status, neighbourhood conditions, social engagement, and individual religious involvement — on health and well-being. Her work has been published in leading journals, including Health & Place, Journal of Aging and Health, Research on Aging, The Gerontologist, Social Science & Medicine, Vaccine, Journal of the American Geriatrics Society, Journal of General Internal Medicine, Archives of Gerontology and Geriatrics, and Social Psychology Quarterly. Currently, she is conducting research on oral health and its relationship with chronic conditions among older adults in Hawai'i.
