David Curtis is an Associate Professor in the Department of Family and Consumer Studies at the University of Utah. His research program is at the intersection of human development, population health, and public policy. He currently leads research projects funded by the National Institutes of Health that address how features of the local environment influence morbidity and mortality outcomes across adulthood. These projects seek to advance understanding of the contextual determinants of two major public health challenges: the obesity epidemic and worsening midlife mortality in the United States.
