Professor David Pedulla is the Professor of the Department of Sociology at Harvard University. He was previously a member of the faculty of Stanford University and the University of Texas at Austin. He received his PhD in Sociology and Social Policy from Princeton University.

His research agenda examines the consequences of nonstandard, contingent, and precarious employment for workers' social and economic outcomes as well as the processes leading to race and gender labor market stratification.

Professor Pedulla's work has appeared in Journals such as *American Sociological Review*, *American Journal of Sociology* and *Social Forces*. His work has been supported by organizations including the National Science Foundation, the Russell Sage Foundation, and the W.K. Kellogg Foundation.
