

Research Methods Training in the Social Sciences

Abstract

In this seminar, Professor Tarani Chandola will discuss current and future training needs in social science research methods. Given significant recent developments in research methods in the social sciences, there is a need to update the provisioning of research methods training across the lifecourse of a researcher, starting from undergraduate to postgraduate and PhD students, and following on throughout the research career trajectory. He will highlight some of the key topics that have been identified as advanced training needs, alongside a discussion of the mode of training and training delivery. Additionally, he will introduce new resources in research methods available to faculty teachers of research methods.
