Dr. Wei Hu is a Principal Economist at the Hong Kong Competition Commission, the statutory body that protects competition in Hong Kong by enforcing the Competition Ordinance. As a competition economist, Dr. Hu's job contents include primarily conducting qualitative and quantitative economic analyses to assist the Commission's investigation and litigation of anti-competitive conducts, and making studies about the competition status in different local industries. Data analysis is an indispensable part of these works. Dr. Hu has been working at the Competition Commission for over seven years, prior to which he was a postdoctoral researcher at the ETH-Zurich after obtaining a PhD in economics from the Toulouse School of Economics.
