Professor Tso is a developmental paediatrician with special interests in neurorehabilitation for children with acquired brain injuries. Professor Tso leads the Paediatric Acquired Brain Injury Program and the Developmental Behavioral Paediatrics Service at the Duchess of Kent Children's Hospital & the Hong Kong Children's Hospital. She has published over 60 original papers in international peer-reviewed journals in the field of paediatric acquired brain injuries and common developmental disorders. She is a Governor of the International Brain Injury Association and is responsible for advocating support for children with brain injuries using evidence-based practices and novel interventions. Professor Tso has contributed significantly in the validation of the Griffiths Development Scales – Chinese, the key assessment tool to assess the developmental profiles of Chinese children. Locally, she has been involved in the design of the parenting curriculum framework for the Educational Bureau, Government of the HKSAR, so to promote wellbeing and optimal development of young children in Hong Kong.
