Dr. Connor is a CASBS fellow at Stanford University and Associate Professor at the Arizona State University. As a computational social scientist and geographer, Dr. Connor studies how places shape human development, social inequality, and the transmission of advantages and disadvantages over extended historical periods. He specialises in causal inference and historical and spatial data infrastructure. In addition to his methodological contributions, he has published extensively on topics including the changing geography of the American Dream, spatial wealth inequality, and environmental analytics. His work has been funded by the National Science Foundation and the National Institute of Health, and discussed in popular outlets including Brookings, Business Insider and Bloomberg.
