She is the sole author of 3 research monographs - *Gender and Work in Urban China: Women Workers of the Unlucky Generation* (Routledge 2007), *Beauties at Work: Gender, Sexuality and Power in Chinese Companies* (Palgrave 2016), *Embedded Generations: Family Life and Social Change in Contemporary China* (Princeton University Press 2025). In 2022, she won Sage best paper prize for her article 'Childhood in urban China: A Three-Generation Portrait' published in *Current Sociology*. From 2023, she joined *The China Quarterly* as the first Chinese editor in its' 63 years of publication history.
