His work appears in top journals like *The Lancet*, *PLoS Medicine*, and *The Lancet Regional Health–Western Pacific*. In 2019, he received the Clark Taylor Professional Paper Award from the Society for Medical Anthropology. Currently, he researches successful caregiving, dementia disclosure, and medico-social care integration. His interdisciplinary approach drives impactful contributions to health social science.
