Wang Jingyu, Ph.D. in Economics, serves as an Assistant Professor at both the School of Public Policy and Management and the Institute for AI International Governance at Tsinghua University. He is also a postdoctoral fellow in Tsinghua University's Shuimu Scholar program. His research focuses on global economic governance and the international governance of AI.

Since joining Tsinghua University, Wang has published a series of papers on the challenges and countermeasures of AI governance, as well as the international comparative studies of AI governance frameworks. He has contributed to major research initiatives, including the Research on Risk Prevention and Governance of New-Generation AI, a key project under China's Science and Technology Innovation 2030 program. Wang also led a research project funded by the China Postdoctoral Science Foundation titled Competition and Cooperation in Sino-US AI International Governance. Additionally, and engaged in practical work and international exchanges on global AI governance, collaborating with government bodies such as the National Development and Reform Commission, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and the Ministry of Science and Technology. In 2024 and 2025, Wang received letters of commendation from the NDRC and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China for his contributions to AI-related projects.
