Cheng Boqing, born in 1966, is Professor of Sociology at Nanjing University. He is currently Vice President of the Chinese Sociological Association. His primary research areas include sociological theory, social governance, sociology of emotions and history of sociology. He has published monographs such as *Georg Simmel: The Diagnosis of Modernity*, *Out of Modernity: A Reorientation of Contemporary Western Sociological Theory*, and *Emotions, Narratives, and Rhetoric: Explorations in Social Theory*. He has authored over 50 academic papers, including “A Sociological Analysis of Contemporary Emotional Regimes”, *Social Sciences in China*, “Passion and society: An Exposition of Marx’s Sociology of Emotions”, *Sociological Research* and “The Rhetoric of Sociology”, *Sociological Research*. The awards he has received include (Humanities and Social Sciences), the First Prize of the Jiangsu Provincial Outstanding Achievement Award in Philosophy and Social Sciences, and the Lu Xueyi Outstanding Sociology Paper Award. As a principal contributor, he has received numerous national Teaching Achievement Awards.
