

Cultivating Meaningful Intergenerational Interactions in High-density Neighbourhoods

There is a vast body of literature on the potential benefits of intergenerational interactions, which underpins efforts to promote intergenerational public spaces and intergenerational programs in various cities. Nevertheless, it is worth taking a step back and pondering this question: Are all forms of intergenerational interactions equally meaningful? In this seminar, the speaker will share key findings from a qualitative study on the perceptions of residents in Hong Kong, highlighting forms of intergenerational interactions that are perceived as meaningful within this specific urban context, and offering ideas on how to cultivate more meaningful intergenerational interactions in high-density neighbourhoods.
