Chen Cheng is an Assistant Professor in the Division of Social Science at The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. She is a cognitive developmental psychologist whose research examines how children develop representations of objects, numbers, and agents, and how these representations support learning and reasoning in early childhood. Specifically, her work investigates how foundational learning capacities such as working memory, attention, and executive control give rise to complex skills such as numerical understanding and logical reasoning. She obtained her Ph.D. in Developmental Psychology from the University of Massachusetts Boston and worked as a postdoctoral researcher at Boston University.
