Duoduo Xu is an Associate Professor of Sociology and the Co-Director of Social Sciences Research Centre (SSRC) at The University of Hong Kong. Before joining HKU, she was a Research Assistant Professor of Social Science and a Junior Fellow of Institute for Advanced Study at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. She received her PhD in Social Science from HKUST, where she was also trained at the Center for Applied Social and Economic Research (CASER). As a stratification researcher and social demographer, her research is situated at the intersection of sociology of education, sociology of work, and urban sociology, with a substantive focus on child development and youth employment issues in urban China. In the capacity of PI or Co-PI, Xu has received several competitive external grants from the Hong Kong Research Grant Council. Her work has appeared in *British Journal of Sociology*, *China Quarterly*, *Chinese Sociological Review*, *Demographic Research*, *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*, *Work, Employment and Society*, among others. She currently serves on the editorial board of *Work, Employment and Society*, and *Chinese Sociological Review*.
