

Understanding Child Learning and Skill Development through Early Childhood Intervention: China REACH

In an effort to reduce income inequalities and enhance social mobility, the China Rural Education and Child Health (China REACH) project was launched in 2015. The China REACH Huachi intervention is a large-scale randomised controlled trial (RCT) designed to assess the impact of a home visiting model for rural households in China. During the program period, we found that children's skills improved significantly. To understand the mechanism by which the program enhances children's skill development, we are tracking these children for ten years. This analysis presents new follow-up results and examines potential mechanisms.
