Edmund W. Cheng is a Professor in the Department of Public and International Affairs and an Associate Dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at City University of Hong Kong, where he directs the Centre for Public Affairs and Law, the Computational Social Sciences Lab, and the Summer Methods School. With publications in top-tier outlets, his work spans political sociology, digital governance, sociology of science, and computational social sciences. He serves as the regional coordinator of the World Values Survey Association, the largest global survey of human values and well-being. Cheng has been ranked among the top 2% of scientists globally by Stanford University from 2020 to 2025, has received the CityUHK Presidential Research Excellence Award, and has won book awards from the American Sociological Association and the American Political Science Association. His research has been supported by the Chinese National Science Foundation, the French National Research Agency, the Hong Kong Research Grants Council, the Central Policy Unit, and the Policy Innovation and Coordination Office, and has been drawn upon by public authorities and quangos. He holds a PhD in Government from the London School of Economics and has held visiting positions at Oxford, Australian National University, and Waseda University.
