CAES9923 Writing Psychology: Text and Context: a second-year course offered in the second semester

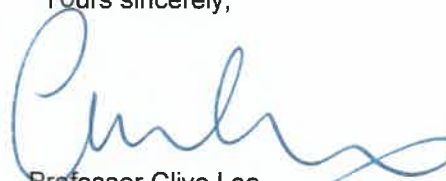
CAES9930 Research Writing in the Social Sciences: a third-year course offered in the second semester

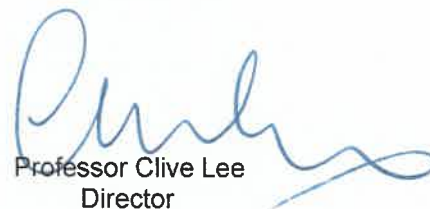
