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Kun Wang, Ph.D., M.S.W., is an assistant professor in the Department of Social Work at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and an associate scientist with UAB's Integrative Center for Aging Research, Alzheimer's Disease Research Center, and Center for the Study of Community Health. Trained in social work with earlier degrees in economics and mathematics, Dr. Wang's research focuses on cognitive aging, digital inequality, and self-perceptions of aging, with particular attention to the social, structural, and digital contexts that shape those processes, as well as their implications for racial and ethnic minority older adults and family caregivers. Dr. Wang has published more than 40 peer-reviewed articles, including first-authored work in *The Gerontologist*, *The Journals of Gerontology Series B*, and *Social Science & Medicine*. Dr. Wang is lead editor of the volume *ICT Use and Healthy Longevity: Empirical Data and Perspectives* (Springer Nature, 2025), and section editor for "ICT Use and Healthy Aging" in Springer's *Encyclopedia of Gerontology and Population Aging*.
