Registration Procedures for New Social Sciences TPg Students

**Checkbox**

- **Step 1.** Complete the Online Master Registration via [HKU Portal](#) immediately after receiving the account details. Please refer to “[Guide to Online Master Registration](#)” for details.

For non-local students who have not yet received the HKID Card at the time of online registration:

- Please leave the ‘HKID Number’ field blank in the Online Master Registration.
- Submit a copy of your HKID Card to your Programme Office as soon as it has been issued.
- Timely submission is strongly advised to ensure your Chinese name, if applicable, is recorded in the University system and included on official documents such as transcript and graduation certificate.



- **Step 2.** Complete and pass the Anti-Scam Quiz within 14 days after finishing the Online Master Registration. Please refer to CEDARS’s [Mandatory Anti-Scam Training](#) for details.



- **Step 3.** Submit a recent photo and identity document(s) online for processing of the Student Registration Card via [HKU Portal](#) (*SIS Menu → Self Services → Student Card Document Upload*). Please refer to the guideline “[Online Submission of Identity Document and Photograph for Student Registration Card](#)” for details.

For non-local and students using a visa to study<sup>1</sup> in Hong Kong:

After you have arrived in Hong Kong, you are required to upload your visa, landing slip, and input the visa expiry date via [HKU Portal](#) (*SIS Menu → Self Services → Compulsory Upload of Visa Docs*). Please refer to the guideline “[Online Submission of Visa, Landing Slip and Visa Expiry Date](#)” for details.

The email for collection of Student Registration Card will **ONLY** be sent to your HKU Portal email account after you have completed the online submission of visa, landing slip and visa expiry date.



- **Step 4.** Submit the signed [Research Ethics Declaration form](#) to the Faculty Office by uploading it to [online submission platform](#) by **August 28, 2026 (Friday)**.



<sup>1</sup> Students studying in Hong Kong on a visa are defined as holders of the following documents issued by the HKSAR Immigration Department: a) dependent visa/entry permit; b) full-time employment visa/work permit; c) student visa/entry permit; d) visa/entry permit for Admission Scheme for the Second Generation of Chinese Hong Kong Permanent Residents; e) visa/entry permit for Capital Investment Entrant Scheme; f) visa/entry permit for Top Talent Pass Scheme; g) visa/entry permit for Quality Migrant Admission Scheme; or h) visa/entry permit under the Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates (IANG). Alternatively, under the [Education Bureau’s definition of local students](#) (<https://www.jupas.edu.hk/en/page/detail/3670/>), students without any LS1-9 documents are also regarded as studying on a visa.

- **Step 5.** Refer to the information provided by your respective Programme Office for details of the orientation activities or induction programmes.

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- **Step 6.** Complete the course selection in the First Semester for both the First Semester and Second Semester, and where applicable, the Summer Semester for certain programmes via the [HKU Portal](#). For procedures of course enrolment, please refer to the guideline “[How to select a course in SIS](#)” (HKU Portal log-in required). Please note that course enrolment requests made after the course selection period are generally not accommodated.
